

**2012 ASG Track and Field Trials
FAQ for Parents and Athletes**

1. Will I make the team?

Chances are very good. We can take up to 20 Girls and 20 Boys and we have 23 Girls and 14 boys pre-registered for tryouts. (I may have a few more day-of-meet entries, though). The team will be posted on www.wolvesac.com by Monday, June 11 at noon.

2. I made the team, now what?

I need to have your completed ASG and ASG fee (\$100 cheque payable to Athletics Alberta) ASAP. PLEASE FILL OUT YOUR FORMS AND LEAVE YOUR CHEQUE WITH MARLENE TODAY BEFORE YOU LEAVE. Once your forms and payment has been submitted, you will receive confirmation from the AB GAMES PEOPLE that you are on the team.

3. What are my responsibilities during the Games?

The Games run Thursday, July 26 through Sunday, July 29 in Lethbridge. You need to stay with the team in the provided accommodation for the duration of the Games. Also, you need to sign and abide by the CODE OF CONDUCT for the duration of the Games. (Code of Conduct is page 2 of your ASG forms – see #2.)

4. Where will we be staying? How does the transportation to and from the Games work?

We will be staying in classrooms in local schools during the Games. You need to bring a sleeping bag – mats are provided. All meals are also provided. Transportation is provided to and from the Games on buses. However, parents are allowed to drive athletes to and/or from the Games.

5. What kind of swag do I get?

A groovy Zone 8 singlet to compete in and a Zone 8 athlete hoody or something similar.

6. What the basic plan once I get to the Games?

The Opening Ceremonies are on Thursday night. Track runs Friday and Saturday during the day. There is athlete entertainment on Friday night and an athlete dance party on Saturday night. Sunday morning you can sleep in, have breakfast and watch other sports. The buses home usually leave early Sunday afternoon.

7. Will the team be holding practices?

Yes. Mondays and Wednesdays in Grande Prairie at the track starting June 13. You're encouraged to come out and train if you can make it. Details on times will be forthcoming.

8. Will the team compete in any meets before the Games?

There's a meet in Sherwood Park on July 14 and 15 that would be good to compete at. Contact the coaches for details.

9. Where do I get more and updated information?
